Comments

Field	Remarks
6	Contains the respective date for the fields 7-9, 10-12, 13-15,...,130-132. This fields remain empty for the days the timetables are closed (Sundays, holidays etc.)
Capacity	Number of hours and minutes that are available on a machine on a certain day. The fields containing the capacities of today and the days before remain empty.
Load	Time the machine is scheduled to run.
Real or actually Available	Real (actually) available means the capacity including past and future load. For example, if a machine with a capacity of 8 hours per day has a load of 6 hours on Monday and 10 hours on Tuesday the overlap (- 2 hours) on Tuesday will be shifted on Monday. This means the real available capacity on Monday will be 0.
